I. Call to Order

Meeting called to order by Chair Ross at 6:30 PM

III. Set/Amend Agenda

McNeilly MOTIONED to accept the agenda as presented. Pinkerton SECONDED. MOTION carried 6-0

IV. Approval of Minutes: Regular Meeting of 4/1/26

MOTION by McNeilly SECONDED by Cady, to approve the 4/1/26 minutes as amended. MOTION carried 6-0

V. Public Comment

Resident asked if the property for the proposed Data Center was in Vevay Township.

Supervisor Lazet pointed out how well the recreation area drained after the significant rain we received over the past 24 hours.

Resident commented that the Ingham County Drain Commissioner made public comments over the past weekend that he would not approve a Data Center from discharging.

A Resident raised concerns about the ability to test well capability over time.

A Resident raised concern that he felt a developer would want to run their emergency generators more than 15 minutes a month.

A Resident suggested that generators be given their own specific setback specifications as well as defining “emergency” generator (to not include energy shaving).

VI. Pending Business


A. Data Center Ordinance

Suggested verbiage was reviewed for Ordinance No. 68.57 Regulation of Data Centers. Sections regarding noise were given significant attention and discussion included means of testing and enforcement. Planning Commissioners will continue to do due diligence as they investigate concerns and compare Vevay Township's Ordinance to those of other municipalities. The current ordinance will require further investigation and community consultation.
