**Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony Final Review.** The Commission reviewed and discussed in detail the final preparations for the ribbon cutting ceremony on June 12, 2025.

**CADL Storywalk Update.** The 17 holes for the individual storybook pages have been dug. The Capital Area District Library has been contacted, and Supervisor Lazet anticipates the storywalk installation within the next week before the ribbon cutting ceremony.

**Easement Update.** The Arnold easement has been finalized, and the Mason Jewett Field Airport easement is in process.

**Any Other Business.** Supervisor Lazet presented a Facebook post regarding the field maintenance and long grass. His response included the explanation that there was substantive deer damage to both the soccer fields and the baseball outfield. The damage stretched almost path to path and east and west across much of the fields. Our contractor smoothed the fields and then drilled in grass seed. The contractor's recommendation was not to mow the newly planted areas until late May or early June. The fields have been mowed at a 4-inch level. The goal is to have the fields back in playable condition by the end of next week.
