WHEREAS, the Vevay Board of Trustees supports the submission of a Michigan Department of Natural Resource Spark Grant for the new construction, renovation and upgrade to the Vevay Township Community Park; and

WHEREAS, the proposed application is supported by the Township's 5-Year Community Parks & Recreation Plan to enhance and increase the quality of life for the residents of Vevay Township by providing a full range of recreation programs, recreation facilities, athletic fields, and pathways to meet their recreational needs; and

WHEREAS, Vevay Township will obligate \$125,000 in match funding.

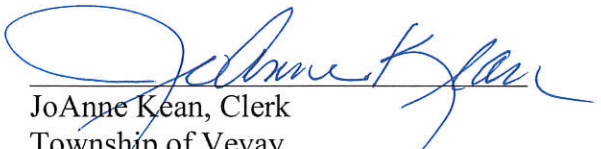
