

Recreation Passport Grant – Restroom Facility. Vevay Township has been awarded a \$150,000 Recreation Passport grant from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources to facilitate the construction of an outdoor restroom in the park. A proposal from Spalding DeDecker to serve as the Prime Professional for this project has been received. Both the authorizing resolution and the proposal are scheduled to be presented to the Vevay Township Board of Trustees at their upcoming meeting.

Any Other Business. Member Fischer provided an update from Lynn Whipple from the PEA Group concerning the south line easement related to the Mike Levine Lakelands Trail State Park and its connection to the Lansing River Trail Adrian Blissfield Rail Corridor.

The Commission considered the potential of submitting an application for the 2025 DALMAC Fund Grant, which would provide funding for a bicycle repair station equipped with an air pump and bike rack. Vice-Chair Emens will research associated costs, while Secretary Ruttan will explore the grant writing process.
